Niall Horan makes a move up the Top 10 this week on TMN's Hot 100 with 'Slow Hands' landing at #2 from #7, boosted by his recent Australian promo visit.

After flirting on the fringes of the Top 10 for the past few weeks, Jonas Blue's 'Mama' finally breaks the barrier at #10, a peak position for the track. It's the DJ's highest Hot 100 position since 'Perfect Strangers' hit #5 in September 2016.

'Versace On The Floor (Remix)', originally off Bruno Mars' *24K Magic*, has enjoyed a somewhat belated bullet-ride to the top as a result of Guetta's delicate touch. It rose 81 places to reach #16 from #97 – an unprecedented rise in the Hot 100 chart's history.

July's survey break made for an unusual week at radio. Among the five Most Added singles this week, two have previously appeared on the list (Jessica Mauboy's 'Fallin' and Hailee Steinfeld's 'Most Girls').

Rudimental's 'Sun Comes Up', featuring British singer James Arthur, was radio's top pick, seeing adds from 108 stations. It was playlisted to the Hit regional network and ACE Radio network, and was the only track added across the board by the Nova network.

After being crowned the winner of The Voice Australia last Sunday, Judah Kelly's single 'Count On Me' instantly got the attention of radio MDs.


